Ouagadougou, in Burkina Faso, is hosting the 4th Milan Urban Food Policy Pact (MUFPP) Regional African forum on February 15th-18th, 2021, organized by MUFPP Secretariat, the City of Ouagadougou, the City of Milan and ACRA, co-funded by AICS and EU.

The MUFPP, launched in Milan in 2015, has been signed globally by 211 cities.

Objectives:

- Facilitate exchange and mutual learning between European and African young activists and professionals on sustainable urban food systems;
- Encourage the participation of youth in urban food policies development and implementation;
- Strengthen among young activists and professionals the self-awareness of their role as change-makers.

Participants

Young students, professionals, activists committed to sustainable food systems, fight against climate change, food security and right to food, already active in civil society organizations and/or in ACRA and Mani Tese projects, target age 18-35 year old.

Participants' selection takes into consideration motivation, participants background, gender and age balance.
